



## Ah Counter Evaluation Sheet

The Ah-Counter notes words and sounds used as a “crutch” or “pause filler” by anyone who speaks during the meeting.

Words may be inappropriate interjections such as, and, well, but, so, you know. Sounds may be ah, um, er.

Also repetition of words or phrases such as “I, I” or “this means, this means” are noted.

These words and sounds can be annoying to listeners. The Ah-Counter role is an excellent opportunity to practice your listening skills.
